It can also be by looking after basic necessities or doing errands whilst the person is pursuing his goals.

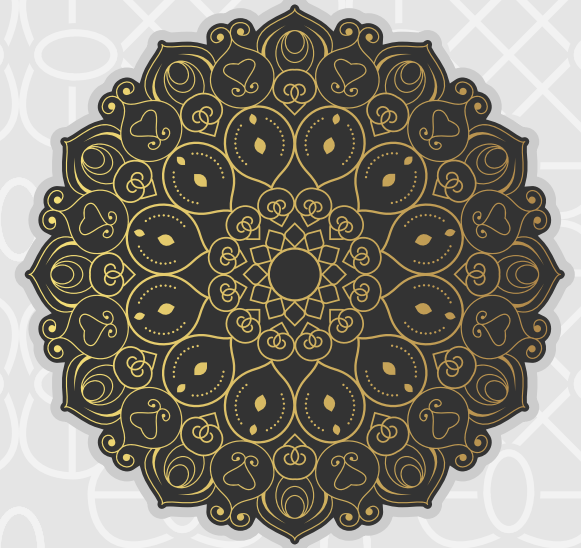
With continuous support and sensitivity, a person will be confident and his self-esteem will be raised, making it easy for him to accomplish his ambition.
